

FR CHRIS WRITES: Last Sunday we had a letter from our Bishop launching the Dawson pastoral plan 2026 to 2030 called "Go make disciples." Four of us went to a presentation in Leicester on Monday which we found very positive. This plan will form the framework and inspiration for our parish going forward. And it is built upon the bishops 3 aims of encountering Christ ever more deeply, growing in discipleship that is to say in our following of Christ and mission that is in sharing our faith in our daily lives in various ways. The heart of the Pastoral Plan is about the spiritual renewal of our parishes, chaplaincies and schools, so that we might encourage and make best use of the gifts and talents of more and more people in our attempts over the next five years to become ever more outward-looking and missionary as a diocese. I hope to form a group of parishioners interested in engaging and seeing how this plan can form our way forward and inspire and renew our Parish. I will consult the PPC who meet shortly.
